Welcome to Term 6!

Mrs Sanders will continue to teach the class. Mrs Gallini and Mrs Shave will be our class TAs. Mrs Gallini will be covering the class on Monday afternoons for Mrs Sanders' PPA (planning, preparation and assessment time).

P.E will take place on Tuesdays (on the field) and on Wednesdays (in the hall).

Main Areas of Learning to be covered

- English: We will be reading Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick. We will be writing setting descriptions, letters, diary entries and our own dystopian story. The children will also be writing a balanced argument about the uses of rivers and the effects on the environment.
- Maths: We will be learning how to add and subtract decimals with different numbers of digits, multiplying and dividing decimals, negative numbers and converting units of measurement.
- Science: We will be learning properties and changes of materials.
- RE: This term we will be asking 'How do Christians decide how to live and what would Jesus do'?
- Wider Curriculum: In Geography our topic is 'Why are trees and forests important?'. In Music our topic will be 'Reflect, Rewind and Reply'.
- In computing we will be using Purple Mash which will be a topic on word processing, and in PE we will be doing athletics. In DT our topic is pulleys and gears.
