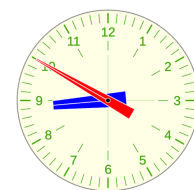
Please provide fruit for snack time rather than crisps or chocolate, as we are a Healthy School.

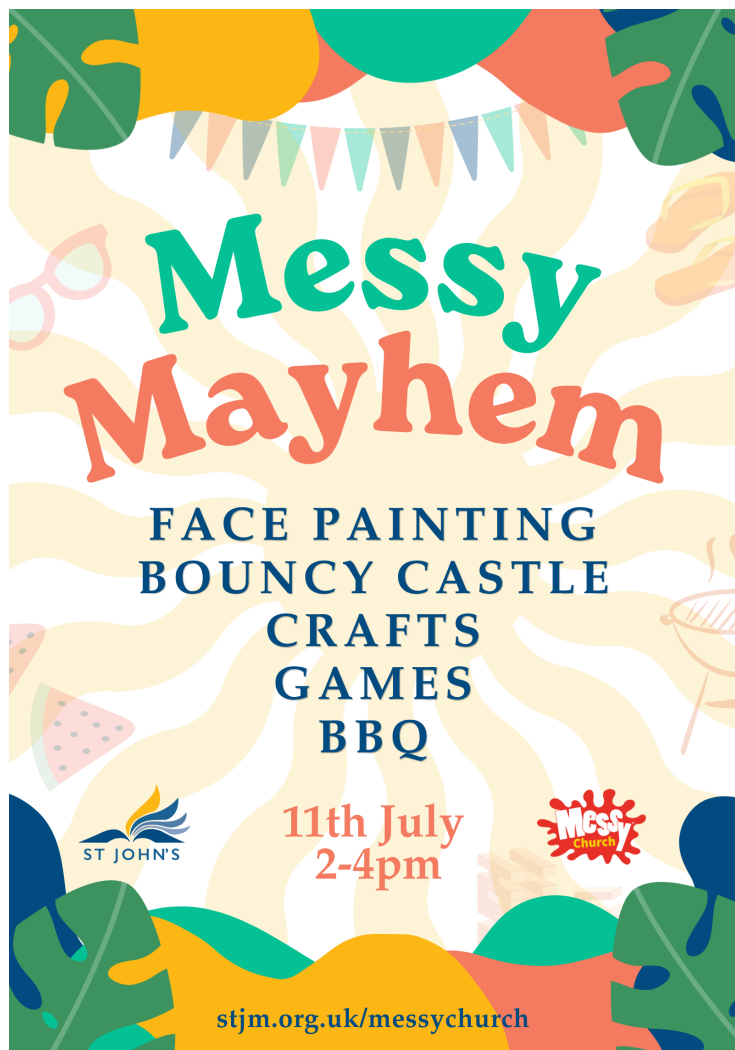

Keeping Children Safe in Sports Clubs This Summer

- What happens if there is an accident or emergency?
- Who can you speak to if you have any concerns or worries?
- What training and qualifications do the staff have?

Helping to ensure that clubs and activity providers have appropriate safeguarding arrangements in place can support a safe, positive and enjoyable experience for all children this summer.
